


Developing a program where a Large Multi-National provides an opportunity to an Alberta and Jalisco Partnership to develop a New Technology or solve a Business Problem.



PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY FOR ALBERTA SMES

- For-profit SMEs under 500 employees
- Business Registered in Alberta
- Align with program areas of technology or sectors
- Technology development projects
- Technology demonstration projects
- Foreign partners must be registered with local S&T
- **Partnership model vs vendor/supplier relationship**





PROGRAM PROCESS

- One round per year, per program
- Companies provide profile/expression of interest after information session
- Al selects companies to travel to region for matchmaking with partners
- Workshops held to understand program, application and region
- Mexico program:
 - Two workshops attendance mandatory
 - Joint applications
- China program:
 - Workshop attendance not mandatory
 - Limited to one matchmaking event
 - Separate applications


PROGRAM FUNDING AND TERM

- Competitive matching grant programs best of best
- Projects are funded up to \$250,000 CDN by each party
 - Each industry partner matches
 - Each jurisdictional government matches
- \$1,000,000 CDN project (plus additional industry commitment)
- Alberta companies commit ½ in-kind and ½ cash

Do the math – for \$125,000 in new cash towards the project, Alberta companies have access to a \$1,000,000 project

- Paid on proof of milestone delivery
- Projects over a 2 years
